CAPTA GROUP CONTINUES UPGRADES AT WILDLIFE HABITAT

Local tourism operator The CaPTA Group is continuing its heavy investment in its iconic Wildlife Habitat Port Douglas with a multi-year project underway.

Phase one commenced in the Wetlands Habitat in 2017 and is near completion, including a new Lumholtz's Tree Kangaroo exhibit, the Stork Walk pathway extension, a rejuvenated koala presentation area, and a new roof on the Curlew Café, home of the world-famous Breakfast with the Birds.

Phase two is now underway, focusing on the crocodile precinct in the Savannah Habitat, which will dramatically enhance current enclosures and improve on the overall guest experience.

The first stage involved the recent successful capture and temporary relocation of the park's nine Freshwater Crocodiles, with this phase expected to reach completion within the next six months and cause minimal disruption to the guest experience.

Phase three improvements are scheduled for 2019, with the aim to overhaul and reimagine the Rainforest Habitat area.

CaPTA Group Research & Development Manager Andrew Hearn, who is overseeing the projects, said he is looking forward to the continued improvement of the attraction.

"It is an exciting time for the Wildlife Habitat as a local iconic experience, with many improvements launching over the next few months," said Mr. Hearn.

"Our commitment to the customer experience is at the forefront of this project, and we look forward to adding on to what is already an exceptional experience."
