Wildlife Keepers were then overjoyed to find a second litter of small, hairless babies clinging to their mother in the enclosure last week, estimated to about three months old.

Rainforestation Head Wildlife Keeper Kate Barnard said although the keepers are overjoyed at the park's smallest additions, they will be closely monitoring future breeding,

"At present the breeding is proceeding well, but to prevent over-populating or interbreeding, we may have to eventually separate males from females or look at swapping some with other Wildlife Parks," she said.

"They're also not quite as innocent as they appear – they may be cute now, but as adults, they can be quite savage with their gnarly teeth!"

Rainforestation Nature Park has three unique attractions: Amphibious Army Duck Tours of the rainforest, the Pamagirri Aboriginal Experience, and the Koala & Wildlife Park. Rainforestation is situated on the Kennedy Highway, 5 minutes from Kuranda Village, and 30 minutes from Cairns.
